



Information on Planned Giving

Thank you for considering including the DRC of Thurston County as a beneficiary in your estate planning. We would be proud to steward your legacy in support of a more peaceful community.

What is a planned gift?

A planned gift may take many forms, and we encourage you to discuss all options with your financial planner or trusted advisor. Here are a few examples of ways you can make a planned gift:

- Name the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County in your estate plan (will or trust).
- Name the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy, annuity or retirement plan.
- Establish a charitable gift annuity with the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County.

Sample wording for an estate gift

Please help us honor your wishes by using the following language in your estate plan:

For a specific bequest (dollar amount or percentage):

I give, devise, bequeath, [insert here the sum, percentage, or description of property] to the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County of Washington State, or its successor organization, a nonprofit corporation as described in section 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code, located at 312 4th Ave East, Olympia WA, 98501, to be used for its tax exempt purposes in offering conflict resolution services and training.

For a residual bequest (the remainder of your estate after you've met family and other goals): I give, devise, bequeath, all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County of Washington State, or its successor organization, a nonprofit corporation as described in section 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code, located at 312 4th Ave East, Olympia WA 98501, to be used for its tax exempt purposes in offering conflict resolution services and training.

For a restricted bequest:

I give, devise, bequeath, _____ to the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County of Washington State, or its successor organization, a nonprofit corporation as described in section 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code, located at 312 4th Ave East, Olympia WA 98501, to be used exclusively for/in [insert restricted-use language here].

Please let us know of your intent to include the Dispute Resolution Center of Thurston County in your estate plans. Especially in cases where the donor wants to restrict the use of the gift, it is important to meet with staff to ensure that we understand and are able to comply with your wishes.
